

MPS is delighted to collaborate this upcoming academic year with EFI and work towards the restoration and preservation of all our ponds and rivers in and around Tirunelveli.





The National Education Policy 2020 has given great emphasis on the integration of general education and vocational education. In this regard, a High-Level Committee (HLC) constituted by the Government of India has formulated National Credit Framework (NCrF). NCrF is an enabling framework that lays down basic principles of creditization of learning

encompassing three main components viz. credits earned from academic grade, skill programme and relevant experience. To further test, refine, and assess their effectiveness in real-world contexts, a pilot implementation of these guidelines has been planned.
